Presentation of the Lord

Since at least by the 4th century, Christians celebrated Candlemas, the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple as "Light of Nations," with a candle-lit procession. In the Old Testament Law of Moses, the firstborn male child belonged to God. Thus, Mary and Joseph, needed to "buy him back" by a sacrifice of two turtledoves or young pigeons. That same day, Mary as mother was also ritually purified after giving birth.

The first reading today is from the Prophet Malachi who preached in Jerusalem about five centuries before Christ, after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon. He calls for hope in the Messiah, the "Messenger," who will come to the Temple and purify the people with fire for a God-fearing obedience to the Law of Moses. We now know God's Messenger to be Christ, who presents himself in the Temple of the Church, lovingly purifying us to take part in the New Covenant of his Death and Resurrection that saves the world.

The second reading from Hebrews affirms that Jesus, tested in his humanity like all humans, has now become merciful and faithful high priest who frees his brothers and sisters from sin and destroys the diabolical power of death. We Christians are among the freed, proclaiming the victory of Christ to a fearful world yet in slavery and longing for divine liberation.

The Gospel reading today places Mary and Joseph in the Temple, "when the days were completed for their purification," to present Jesus as first-born. They offer the sacrifice called for by the Law of Moses. There they first encounter the old and Spirit-filled Simeon, who was personally promised by God to see the long-awaited redemption of Israel. As he holds the child, he recognizes the redeeming Messiah and glorifies God for the Light he is. He also prophesies pain for the Messiah's mother. Mary and Joseph also encounter Anna, the elderly widow who made the Temple her home as she awaited the Messiah. With a thankful heart, she begins to speak to the people of the child before her. In our Baptism, we first beheld the Messenger of Light and Savior of the world. At that moment, our eyes became focused on him and our hearts given to his mission for the world.
