The garden of new life...

We are well into Lent, when the already baptized take responsibility for personal infidelities against Christ and their baptismal vows and when new "recruits" (catechumens) prepare for Baptism.

On this 3rd Sunday of Lent, Israel is an example for us, the Christian Church, on the journey to God and the final Kingdom. In the reading from Exodus, Israel is revealed as a people once rescued from the nightmare of slavery in Egypt. Through Servant Moses, she learns the name of the God of her fathers who delivers her, "I AM WHO AM." In the experience of the "Burning Bush," that name is seared forever into her collective memory to keep her faithful to God. We Christians, too, reverence the name of God's Servant, JESUS, by which we are delivered. It is seared in our spirit at Baptism and recalled, with both remorse and joy, on our Lenten journey.

In the second reading from I Corinthians, Paul links the Christian community's redemptive experience to Israel's. Israel made its way out of slavery through the desert, depending always on a spiritual rock that fed her and gave her drink. (The Rock would later be revealed as Christ.) Israel's infidelities against God on the journey to the Promised Land serve as a warning to Christians who are journeying. To keep us from desiring evil things as Israel did and stop us from grumbling against God and risking death, we Christians take the Lenten passageway toward fullness of life in Christ. Lent is God's grace for second chances to correct our waywardness.

Luke's Gospel contains warnings about losing the saving way through stories of massacres and falling towers. Jesus is clear: human and spiritual disaster awaits us on detours from Baptismal commitment. Jesus' parable of the unbearing fig tree is a "heads-up" for us all. By the grace of Jesus' Cross and Resurrection, each of us has been planted in a Garden of New Life. Why, then, do we expose ourselves to elements of sin and risk the axe of the gardener? But wait! There is still hope. Lent is a time of recovery for us, if only we cultivate and fertilize one more time. The choice is each of ours: will Easter 2025 be my deadline or my lifeline?

Jubilee 2025 – Pilgrims of Hope - What is a Jubilee Year? A Holy Year of the forgiveness of sin, conversion and joyful celebration. The word "jubilee" comes from the Hebrew word yobel, which refers to the ram's horn used to announce a jubilee in the Old Testament. Jubilee 2025 was proclaimed by Pope Francis in the Papal Bull Spes Non Confundit ("Hope does not disappoint"). The Diocese of St. Cloud launched a new Pilgrimage Passport Project for the Jubilee Year 2025: Pilgrims of Hope. This passport includes a list of pilgrimage sites (including the Shrine of St. Odilia in Onamia!) as well as spiritual and corporal works of mercy.
