With each new liturgical year...

Every Sunday in Ordinary Time, a first reading from the Old Testament corresponds in theme with the Gospel reading. A second reading, for Christian instruction, is from the letters of Paul and James. A third reading from the Gospels follows a three-year cycle. In year A, Matthew's Gospel is read. In year B, Mark's Gospel is read (interrupted for five weeks after the 16th week of the year, by readings from John 6). In year C (ours of 2025) Luke's Gospel is read. (The readings at daily Mass have their own organization.)

A Responsorial Psalm, capturing the shared theme of the 1st and Gospel readings, is the people's sung response to the 1st reading. On this 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time, the first reading from Nehemiah is a public proclamation of the Law of Moses to the Jews after their return to Jerusalem from Exile in Babylon. For the first time in seventy years and with great emotion, the liberated Jews hear their beloved Torah read to them by the priest, Ezra, and explained anew by their governor, Nehemiah. They are urged to celebrate. Every reading of the Word of God is "Spirit and Life" sings the Responsorial Psalm and a new beginning in our life as believers.

In the second reading from 1 Corinthians, St. Paul illustrates the Church as the Body of Christ, with many interdependent and diverse members, forming a unified community. Each member, with a Spirit-given gift, plays a critical role, with less honorable or presentable members given the greater honor. The suffering or joy of each is the suffering or joy of all. For these reasons, none of us dares to tolerate any division among ourselves.

The Gospel reading begins St. Luke's inspiration "to write . . . down in an orderly sequence" the sayings and deeds of Jesus to give certainty of faith to the Church. Luke opens with Jesus proclaiming himself the fulfillment of the Scriptures from the prophet Isaiah. "The Spirit of the Lord . . . has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives." With each new liturgical year, our salvation in Jesus is retold and his saving grace deepens within us.
