The Fourfold Presence of Christ at Mass

Our Catholic Catechism says that Jesus is present to us in four ways when we celebrate the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. He is present to us in the Congregation, in the ministry of the Priest, in the proclamation of Sacred Scripture and in the bread and wine after they become the Body and Blood of Christ.

In the Congregation

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus said, "Where two or three come together in My Name, I will be there." Thus, when we walk into church, we should see the Lord living in His people.

In the Ministry of the Priest

The second way we are in His presence is through the Ministry of the Priest. The priest stands in place of Jesus who was the presbyter for the Last Supper.

In the Proclamation of Scripture

When the Scriptures are proclaimed well and faithfully, and when we listen to them attentively, we are in the presence of the Lord. It is the Word of the Lord that we are hearing!

In The Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist

When the priest proclaims the Eucharistic Prayer, the Holy Spirit changes the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. We are called to recognize the real presence of Christ when the priest says, "Behold the Lamb of God." Our eyes do not see the Lord but through faith we recognize His presence.
