

Return

The most significant event in Jewish history is the Exodus, the release from Egyptian slavery. Isaiah reminds the Israelites of the ancient tale in today's first reading as they look forward to returning from seventy years of Babylonian exile. That return is much like the escape through the Red Sea centuries before. But Isaiah gives it a twist. What God is doing now is entirely new. It provides even deeper hope for the future of the Chosen People!

In his letter to the Philippians, Paul speaks about the "prize of God's upward calling" that he has been passionate about all his Jewish life. Rigorously observing the Mosaic Law, he considers himself on the perfect path towards it. But that all changes when he meets Christ. Whatever was "religion" to him before, he throws away as so much rubbish. Reaching God's prize now is knowing Christ and the power of his Resurrection and sharing in his Death. Paul is now on the return path to God's true prize that the Mosaic Law could no longer assure him of.

Luke's Gospel tells the story of the woman caught in adultery. To Jewish eyes, she has given up her right to life. But Jesus intervenes, writing on the ground in the presence of her accusers, perhaps to remind them of something the Prophet Jeremiah teaches: those who turn away and forsake God are "written in the earth" (17:13). Was anyone with stone in hand free of sin themselves? They drop the stones and go away. Jesus invites the woman to return to a new life without sin.

Lent is about return. Whatever evil holds us captive in our "Babylons." Christ can release us from for a return to joyous freedom again. Whatever rubbish we have substituted for God in our lives, we can walk away from, hand in hand with Christ, for a return to decency and goodness. Whatever our infidelity to God, Christ can lovingly embrace us into a return to a more committed life. There is time to return. Lent is not yet over.
