## Ordinary Time

The Sunday after the Baptism of the Lord brings us again to Ordinary Time. "Ordinary" here does not mean "not special." The numbering of the Sundays is simply how the Church orders her yearly liturgical calendar. There are two periods, one after Christmas and a second after Easter (a total of 33 or 34 weeks, depending on how the festivities fall). During Ordinary Time, Catholic Christians focus on Christ's public ministry, maturing their faith while awaiting his Second Coming.

On this Second Sunday in Ordinary Time (The Baptism of the Lord always replaces the First Sunday), the Prophet Isaiah voices a resounding confirmation of God's Will for Israel and her vocation. While she has suffered for infidelity, she will be reinstated as the Lord's beautiful bride. We, the Church, are now the beloved bride transformed.

The second reading, from I Corinthians, speaks of God gifting his Bride-People for mission. The one Spirit gives diverse and wondrous gifts to us for service in our mission.

The Gospel reading from John recounts the first of Jesus' "signs," the first of seven wondrous deeds that show God intervening in human history in a new way through Christ. Manifesting his Messianic glory by the changing of water into wine, Jesus inspires belief in his disciples. Jesus' mother, pressing him for the miracle, moves him toward the "hour" of his redeeming passion, death, resurrection, and ascension. The sign at Cana remains for us disciples today a powerful inspiration to embrace God's plan in Christ.
